Advanced Student Quarters

TGS Policy:	Department can request to use use allocated Advanced Student Quarters (ASQs) to support 6th-year students. In some cases, exceptions may be made for 7th-year students. ASQ use for students beyond year 7 is not allowable.
Recording use for 6th-year student:	Advanced Student Quarter Request Form
Requesting use for 7th-year student:	Advanced Student Quarter Request Form
Who Enters Funding?	Weinberg Dean's Office

Student Banked Quarters

TGS Policy:	TGS provides a 1:1 match up to an additional four quarters of support to be used through the summer of 6th-year for students who are awarded and accept an external competitive award within their first five years of study.
To check student bank eligibility:	Contact Weinberg Dean's Office
Who enters funding?	Department enters funding in Smart Pages, using Item type provided for Student Banked Quarters.

External Awards: Stipend Top-Up / \$500 monthly supplement / Tuition Scholarships

TGS Policy:	Students receiving an external competitive award within their first six years are eligible for: <ul style="list-style-type: none">· In years 1-5: stipend top-up to TGS base rate, tuition scholarship, \$500 monthly supplement*· In year 6: stipend top-up to TGS base rate, tuition scholarship <p>* To qualify for \$500 monthly supplement, award stipend provided must be at least 50% of TGS base stipend rate. If between 40-50% of the TGS base stipend, student qualifies for a \$250 monthly supplement.</p>
To verify top-up, tuition, and supplement eligibility:	Contact Weinberg Dean's Office
Who enters stipend top up and tuition scholarship?	Department enters in Smart Pages. Enter award name in comments.
Who enters \$500 supplement?	Contact Weinberg Dean's Office

*Applies to most humanities and social science departments. Check with your program or the Weinberg Dean's Office for eligibility.
